

Portfolio Guidelines

We are looking for different types of work that show your expertise gained through previous education and through potential professional experience in your field and – if applicable – in interior design.

Potential types of work:

- student work from your previous degree program(s)
- projects from your professional experience in design offices
- projects done as a freelancer
- group work or individual work

Please provide information about each project's context and your specific role/contribution. Include a brief caption text that

- provides all relevant information for each project
- indicates university projects and their origin (3rd semester/short project/final project?)
- distinguishes your own freelance work from projects done for design offices
- defines the scope of what you did (e.g. Was it joint work [of how many]? Did you design it, or render it? Did you design the interior, the landscape, the facade and/or the building shown in the project?)

Most importantly, your portfolio should

- show your range of experiences in your previous field
- show your interest in interior design e.g. by highlighting interior aspects and interior projects where applicable

Please bear in mind that we would like to be able to understand each project and provide conclusive material such as:

- technical drawings (e.g. plans, sections, [interior] elevations, details)
- renderings and/or perspectives
- sketches and/or conceptual drawings
- a short introduction text for the project and information on the context (as described above)

Please include 10 samples from your work compiled in a single PDF; the maximum file size should not exceed 25 MB.
